

1. Introduction

The East Africa Law Society (EALS) is inviting members to submit manuscripts for consideration for publication in the 2nd volume of the EALS Human Rights and Rule of Law Journal.

This journal was created to deliver the Society's mandate of monitoring the state and progress of respect and promotion of human rights and Rule of Law in the East African region. This mandate also includes overseeing the conduct of public interest litigation, publishing Rule of Law Reports, issuing public statements against abuses of human rights and Rule of Law, making policy and legal reform recommendations to the EAC and state governments and undertaking general advocacy on human rights and rule of law in the region.

The Journal among others aims at providing critical contemporary analyses of the state and progress of respect for and promotion of human rights and Rule of Law in East Africa. It is expected to play a critical role in improving understanding of the region's state of human rights as well as Rule of Law concerns and developments which will in turn inform better and more effective Policy discourse and other desirable actions for change.

2. Scope and Style of the Journal

The Journal accepts unpublished manuscripts on Human Rights and the Rule of Law within the member states of the East African Community (currently Burundi, Kenya, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda and the Democratic Republic of Congo).

Submissions may include articles, commentaries, case and book reviews. The editorial board encourages submissions that employ a multidisciplinary approach.

3. House Style

All manuscripts must be in conformity with the 4th edition of the Oxford University Standard for the Citation of Legal Authorities which can be accessed at: https://www.law.ox.ac.uk/sites/files/oxlaw/oscola_4th_edn_hart_2012.pdf

The manuscripts must be typed

Font type: Times New Roman

Font size: 12 (10 for footnotes)

Line spacing: 1.5 (1, for footnotes).

4. Word Limit

Articles: 8000-12,000 words including footnotes

Case and book reviews: 2000 words including footnotes

Commentaries and updates on recent legal developments: 1,500 words including footnotes.

5. Titles and Sub-titles

Title of the manuscript must be written in bold, upper case and must not be longer than **16 words**.

All subtitles must be written in bold lower case with each first letter of major words in uppercase.

6. Numbering and Structure

All main titles and sub-titles must be numbered and styled as follows:

Author's name (with biographical information in a footnote)

1.0 Main Subtitle

1.1.0 Subtitle

1.1.1.0 Further Subtitle
